The Aircargo Club Deutschland (ACD) was founded in 1963 with the ideas of discussing and promoting airfreight transportation. Its roughly 260 members are leading representatives of the airfreight business with multiple Germany wide as well as international responsibilities. They stand for a growing phenomenon which connects people, countries, branches of business and helps facilitate global trade.

The ACD is a non-profit organization; it deals on an independent level solely with relation and communication matters concerning the airfreight industry. It encourages dialog within the field of logistics, promotes innovation, invites discussions about trends and new developments and is generally regarded a sign of the overall felt fascination with worldwide industry.

Airfreight today represents an irreplaceable part of global logistics, connecting industry and trade – airfreight today is the motor of world economy. Compared to virtual merchandise value, roughly on third of all worldwide production is being moved via airfreight.

Worldwide economy cannot exist without a well-functioning flow of merchandise. Industries such as automobile, pharmaceutical, textile etc. are operating their production sites anywhere in the world and, therefore, need to move their respective materials and parts to those final production sites to enable assembly.
